**Addendum Minutes - Meeting Sub-Committee for Ladies' Alpine Skiing,
Costa Navarino (GRE), Monday, 14th May 2018**

Please find below the Addendum to the Ladies' Committee Minutes:

PK and LJ: Highlighted the difficult situation when athletes of various standards train and race on the same level downhill course. There is a need for more speed races organised for younger and less experienced racers.

PK said that safety nets needed to be in place before any training starts.

PK pointed out, that for safety reasons safety nets for training courses (also for SG, GS, SL) would also be important.

PK wanted to know if parallel events could be better harmonised in order to make it clearer for every racer and for the public to understand. There are now parallel city events, team events, GS- events and SL events, mostly with different modes and conditions of qualification. Should there be some sort of standardised procedure?

Whilst as every event, including parallel events, counts towards the World Cup there is a mismatch between technical events and speed events on the World Cup circuit.

The Ladies' committee did not agree that there **MUST** be a 30% gender balance on all committees, but that this should develop naturally and gradually according to merit rather than gender.

The Ladies' committee has requested information from all its members regarding how their NSAs are tackling sexual harassment and bullying. This information should be available at the next Committee Meeting.
